Service Disruption:

On Monday, December 4th there was a service disruption at our Columbia Heights (Longview) site.

Sometime prior to 13:30 commercial power was lost in the area where our Longview Heights site is located. Power disruption was due to the weather. However, due to a bad temperature sensor on our generator, this resulted in a Hi Temp alarm and subsequent shutdown of this machine.

C911 Staff moved our radio system to our "Back-up / Stand Alone" which maintained our ability to communicate with hour end user agencies until such time as Day Wireless restored us back to full service.



We resumed full service by 14:15 or about 45 minutes after the event started.

There were no adverse impacts on our delivery of call taking or dispatch service. The failed temperature sensor has been replaced.
